Declarations of interest (if any) CP handed in DOI form.</p> <p>3. Transfer of Care Around Medicines (TCAM) MH; lead for IPMO pilot, gave a brief presentation on a project hopefully being launched around Black Country STP at the end of September. The Transfer of Care Around Medicines (referral of inpatients in hospital to community pharmacy at discharge through a safe and secure platform) pilot began in April in conjunction with West Midlands Academic Health Science Network. MH covered the scope of problem, benefits to patient and DG NHS Trust/CCG, platform of choice, barriers, implementation and sustainability and next steps. Services – Chlamydia Screening service now on PharmOutcomes with reminder to give out kits to under 25s during EHC consultations with link to c card service – sexual health services are now more joined up.
