### 3. Transfer of Care Around Medicines (TCAM)

MH; lead for IPMO pilot, gave a brief presentation on a project hopefully being launched around Black Country STP at the end of September. The Transfer of Care Around Medicines (referral of inpatients in hospital to community pharmacy at discharge through a safe and secure platform) pilot began in April in conjunction with West Midlands Academic Health Science Network. MH covered the scope of problem, benefits to patient and DG NHS Trust/CCG, platform of choice, barriers, implementation and sustainability and next steps. Followed by discussion and questions.

*CPDO – MD* gave a brief update. Notes in drive. HLP -Developed Level 2 framework & support sheets. Services – Chlamydia Screening service now on PharmOutcomes with reminder to give out kits to under 25s during EHC consultations with link to c card service – sexual health services are now more joined up. Training – more one to one training with local contractors. Meeting – attended Falls meeting 4<sup>th</sup> July falls meeting - awareness session to be held in September. Campaigns - BeeHIVe awareness events to be held in pharmacies leading up until November HIV awareness day. Summer leaflets available to support older people during summer months. Website – work carried out on Think Pharmacy home page and sexual health page. *Meds Management/Office of Public Health - JS* gave a brief update. MECS – updated dry eye guidance and new platform going live Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July. Current activity fairly low but expect increase in uptake as certain formulary ocular lubricants become allowed. PCNs – Clinical leads appointed but no significant changes/advances to report.
